KATAHDIN HUNT FUTILE

Fifth Day of Search Yields No Sign of Rye, N. Y., Boy

MILLINOCKET, Me., July 22 (A).

--An army of 300 searchers concluded unsuccessfully tonight the fifth day of exploring Mount Katahdin for Donn Fendler, 12, of Rye,

N. Y., lost in the 5,273-foot summit's wilderness.

Augmented by fresh volunteers, the band of National Guardsmen, timber cruisers and forestry wardens searched from dawn to dusk the dangerous slopes over which it is feared the boy might have toppled to his death.

State Police Sergeant Frank Hall, search director, planned to push the hunt over the week-end with the aid of expert climbers.
