Gets Word at Amateur Station Where Neighbors Kept Watch

RYE, N. Y., July 25.—On the verge of abandoning hope that Donn Fendler would be found alive, relatives and friends of the boy rejoiced excitedly this afternoon when word of finding him came by radio, telephone and telegraph.

Donn is a son of Mr. and Mrs. Donald G. Fendler of 9 Newberry Place, this village. He has a twin brother, Ryan; another brother, Thomas, and two sisters, Patricia and Nancy. The family was spending the Summer at Newport, Me.

Prayers for the boy had been offered in the Rye churches and neighbors had gathered many times a day at the home of Mr. and Mrs. Charles A. Kibling, 336 Oakland Beach Avenue, to listen to Morse code messages from Maine over a 250-watt amateur sending and receiving station in the residence.
