BANGOR, Me., July 29 (AP).—Donn Fendler, 12, of Rye, N. Y., who battled for life through thirty-five miles of wilderness for eight days after becoming lost on Mount Katahdin, today received the homage of his fellow Boy Scouts of Maine and the commendation of the Bangor City Council. The Scouts brought an Indian war club and other tokens of esteem to the bedside of their hero in the Eastern Maine General Hospital where he is recovering from foot injuries.
