## **Pine Point Neighbors and Citizens of Scarborough**

- The Town of Scarborough has been in <u>private talks</u> with the owners of the Lighthouse Motel on Depot St.
- Depot St. is a <u>public road</u> to the beach, although many think it's private motel property because it has been barricaded for years.
- The motel only owns **18-20** <u>inches</u> of land in front of its motel, and a parking strip on the other side of Depot. St.
- Depot St. is a very important **<u>public shore access</u>** point for fishermen, beachgoers, emergency vehicles, horse owners, etc.
- The motel owners want to "swap" land with the Town. Why? What are their motives?
- The Town Manager has indicated that he has a tentative plan which <u>may</u> go to the Town Council **THIS WEDNESDAY JUNE 17th**
- The Town has disclosed very few details.
- No public notification has been made, no public forums held.
- The Plan would <u>GIVE</u> the motel <u>ALL of the Public Street</u> along the front of the motel right to the beach!
- The Town would get the **20** foot wide parking area the motel own across from the motel (where the motel put up the stockade fence).
- This is the second time the motel has tried to acquire precious Town land.
- The last time a **1-for-1** swap was proposed, (just moving the motel parking in front of the motel).
- This time, the motel would get an almost 2-for-1 deal <u>they would get</u> <u>50 feet, the town would get 20.</u>
