Materials for Related Activities

Preparing the Learner (pre-viewing tasks)

Connect Prior Knowledge

Present Concepts (check concept density)

Introduce Vocabulary

Expected Tasks During Viewing

Schedule of Viewing Pauses (if applicable)

Follow-up: Post-viewing Activities to Reinforce Concepts

Assessment Tasks

Lesson Notes-reflection
